

CHS 2025 Scholarship Application

Deadline to apply is by Friday, April 18, 2025 at midnight

Up to eight scholarships will be awarded from \$500 to \$1,000. Award winners will be notified May 23, 2025. Applicants will be judged on academic achievement, community involvement and a short essay.

The award ceremony will be held at 11:30 am June 11, 2025 at the Woman's Club of Claremont, 343 W. Twelfth Street, Claremont, CA 91711. Lunch will be provided for each of the selected students and two of their family members.

Awarded funds will be provided to the student by check once proof of Fall 2025 enrollment is provided to the Woman's Club Scholarship Committee by the selected student.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a graduating high school senior in the Claremont Unified School District
- Have a 3.0 GPA or higher on their Fall 2024 report card
- Be enrolled at a university, college, or trade school for the Fall semester 2025

- 2. Attach essay following prompt in application and save using your name in the file name "doe.jane WCC essay.docx or .pdf"
- 3. Attach a copy of your unofficial Fall 2024 transcript
- 4. Submit the finished application, essay, and transcript via email to scholarships.womansclub@gmail.com. Deadline is Friday, April 18, 2025 at midnight.
- 5. Applying for this scholarship grants the WCC permission to use your likeness in a photograph, video, or other digital media ("photo") in any and all of its publications, including web-based publications, without payment or other consideration.
